My research has been directed towards kidney diseases, pathophysiological mechanisms and treatment – with special focus on diabetic nephropathy and cardiovascular disease. National coordinator and member of the steering committee in the SHARP study, randomized to more than 9000 patients, Lancet 2011 ;377:2181-92. My present focus is on cardiovascular risk in patients with chronic kidney disease as well as the incretin hormones in renal disease.

Scientific Advisor. Supervisor of 3 doctoral theses (dr.med.) and 11 Ph.D. theses at the University of Copenhagen. Ongoing Ph.D. projects: 2 projects studying aspects of incretin hormones in chronic renal disease. Official opponent at 7 Danish and 5 foreign doctoral theses (Stockholm, Amsterdam, Oslo and Tromsø).
