Research areas include 1) the role of growth factors and sex steroids for pubertal growth and development, 2) the effect of intrauterine growth retardation on postnatal growth and reproduction, 3) relation between IGF-I, reproductive hormones and adult lifestyle diseases, 4) testosterone levels in adolescents and adult males, and the definition of hypogonadism at all ages, 5) Klinefelter syndrome, 6) genetic polymorphisms and association to testicular function, 7) timing and regulation of normal puberty and its disorders, 8) Endocrine disrupting chemicals and their influence on endogenous hormones in children and adults.
